HOW TO JOIN

Ready to Join? Follow these steps and contact one of our experienced recruiters, ready to assist you with the process.

1. INTERVIEW

Meet with your recruiter in their office where you will prescreened for health, drug use, law violations and body art.

2. ASVAB

The ASVAB exam is a computer based test given to everyone who enters any branch of the military. The Air Guard uses your scores to determine your abilities and the jobs available to you to choose from directly related to your score.

3. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

All applicants must complete the physical examination at MEPS (Military Entrance Processing Station) located in Kansas City. You will required to provide your complete medical history and be given a complete physical exam.

4. JOB SELECTION

With the ASVAB and MEPS visit complete, you will be given a curtailed list of jobs available to you. Pick your desired job off of that list.

5. OATH OF ENLISTMENT
